

EAGLES' NEST SHIRAZ 2013



Eagles' Nest, located on the crest of Constantia Nek pass, is nestled at the foot of the awe inspiring Table Mountain. This pristine and boutique family owned vineyard (38 Ha in size) has in recent years gained a striking reputation for both its beauty and award winning wines.

Uniquely characteristic of its wines is its signature of finesse, derived from the cooler climate conditions its vines are exposed to as a result of its elevation and close proximity to the oceanic body that is False Bay, thus delivering very distinctive wines not found elsewhere in South Africa.

Quality and consistency is paramount at Eagles' Nest. Our unique terroir, combined with meticulous attention to detail in the vineyards and cellar, yields wines that are the epitome of elegance and balance.

The vineyard aspects range from east to north, and are perfectly positioned for a cool climate Shiraz. All grapes were hand picked, de-stalked and crushed into medium sized open top fermenters. Punch-downs or pump-overs were performed three to four times per day. Fermentation took 12 days to complete, after which the free run wine was drawn off and the skins were pressed. The wine was then racked into French oak barrels. After 20 months in barrel, selected components of the wine were blended to create a complex and harmonious finished product.

The 2013 Eagles Nest Shiraz is a bright fresh and lively purple colour. On the nose, aromas of ripe red berry fruit, crushed red pepper kernel, violets, and savoury crushed bramble leaf. A creamy mouth filling tannin, with integrated pepper spice embrace your taste buds and are deliciously dry. This wine screams cooler vintage, with elegant spice and restrained fruit all focused by balanced acidity (suggests age-ability). A truly great wine from maturing vineyards, this wine will age gracefully for 15 years from vintage.
